

Effective December 15, 2021, TriCore Reference Laboratories will be consolidating the options for urine toxicology testing in an effort to simplify the ordering process. Summaries of the changes are described in Table 1. Table 2 provides ordering recommendations for clients who need to switch from a discontinued test. See Table 3 on the reverse for components of each drug screen.

**TABLE 1: TRICORE'S DRUG SCREEN OPTIONS AS OF DECEMBER 15, 2021**

TEST NAME	TEST CODE	TEST DESCRIPTION	UTILITY
Urine Drug Screen	UDSCN	Screen only. Positive results are NOT confirmed.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Useful for medical purposes when confirmation of positive results is not needed.</li> <li>False positive and false negative results are possible.</li> </ul>
Urine Drug Screen w/reflex	UDSCNR	Screen + reflex to confirmatory testing of any drugs that screen positive.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Useful when a positive result will change patient management.</li> <li>False positive results are unlikely; the confirmation is highly specific.</li> </ul>
Urine Pain Management Compliance w/reflex	UPMCR	Definitive testing for commonly prescribed opioids + drug screen w/reflex to confirmatory testing for other drugs.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Assess compliance with prescription opioids and abstinence from other drugs.</li> <li>Includes a more sensitive and specific opioid panel to reduce false negative results for prescribed opioids.</li> <li>Includes a drug screen with confirmation to reduce false positive results for non-prescribed drugs.</li> </ul>
Urine Pain Management Compliance	UPMC	Definitive testing for commonly prescribed opioids + drug screen for other drugs. Positive screen results are NOT confirmed.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Same as UPMCR, except drugs that screen positive are not confirmed.</li> <li>Useful to assess compliance with prescription opioids.</li> <li>UPMCR is the preferred test if also testing for abstinence from non-opioid drugs.</li> </ul>
Pain Management Screen	UPAIN	Screen for multiple drugs (see table) + reflex to confirmatory testing for positive opiate and benzo screens.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Low- to moderate-risk pain management patients.</li> <li>A positive result for the prescribed drug is consistent with compliance; a negative result does not indicate non-compliance.</li> <li>False positives and false negative screening results are possible.</li> </ul>
Substance Abuse Screen	USAP	Screen + reflex to confirmatory testing for amphetamine, benzodiazepines, and buprenorphine.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Low- to moderate-risk substance abuse patients with concern for amphetamine and/or benzodiazepine abuse.</li> </ul>
